Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to invite your organization to nominate candidates to participate in the United Nations Humanitarian Civil-Military Coordination (UN-CMCoord) course for the Europe region. This UN-CMCoord course aims to promote appropriate and effective humanitarian civil-military interactions in humanitarian emergencies through bolstered knowledge of and adherence to UN-CMCoord standards and principles. This includes the use of assets to better support the humanitarian community in providing emergency services to people in need.

The course will be held in the Hague, the Netherlands, from 20 to 24 October 2019. The Civil-Military Cooperation Centre of Excellence (CCOE) will generously host and sponsor the event. The training venue, board and accommodation will be free of charge for the participants. We kindly ask your organization to care for travel and applicable allowances.

The course will be residential, with approximately 24 participants comprising of a diverse group of experienced men and women currently working in the Europe region. The course will prioritize nominations from national disaster management authorities, military, civil defence and police organizations, Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, NGOs and UN agencies.

Selected participants are expected to arrive in the Hague on Sunday 20 October, before 4:00 p.m., and depart from the venue on Friday 25 October at any time. The agenda, along with the administrative facts and background documents, will be shared with the selected participants at a later stage.

Applicants must complete the UN-CMCoord e-Course at <https://www.usipglobalcampus.org/training-overview/uncmcoord/> before applying for this UN-CMCoord course. They can choose to obtain a certificate for either “Chapter 5: Working in Natural Disasters” or “Chapter 6: Working in Complex Emergencies”.
