Resilience Actors – Do we know what we don't know?

This interactive online seminar will explore the resilience and preparedness activities of organizations across the alliance, and how those efforts can be cohesive and work at common purpose.

With the renewed attention to resilience and preparedness across the alliance, do the key players act with awareness of each others' efforts or is the velocity of action across the Alliance producing silos of effort that undermine a coordinated and collective response?

This CCOE Online Seminar will explore the contemporary resilience landscape through the lens of the actors that contribute to the prevention, preparedness, response, recovery, and adaptation functions of resilient societies. The seminar will provide insights into NATO's approach to resilience and civil preparedness, the European Union's resilience framework, and a national example illustrating how resilience is implemented in practice.

Beyond examining individual approaches, the seminar will discuss the various frameworks that shape resilience activities and the relationships between governmental institutions, armed forces, emergency services, critical infrastructure operators, private industry, non-governmental organisations, academia, and local communities. Particular attention will be given to identifying gaps, overlaps, and emerging actors whose influence on resilience may be underestimated or insufficiently understood.
